"Reaching the Artistic Soul of our Youth Through the Education of Dance"



INFORMATION AND APPLICATION

PURPOSE

The Dream Maker Scholarship was established to provide dancers who are actively studying dance, but demonstrate a financial need, with tuition scholarships to Price Performing Arts Center (PPAC) to further their dance training and education. This award gives dancers the exclusive opportunity to use their dance abilities and scholastic achievements to be eligible to receive this scholarship award. Up to two dancers per year are eligible to receive this award.

AWARD

The award is for the 2008-2009 school year and is for tuition only. The award will be divided by quarters, as defined by PPAC's school year. Award payments will be given directly to PPAC. The maximum award paid in one school-year is \$750. In order to receive and continue to receive the award, the recipient must maintain active and consistent attendance at PPAC, adhere to all rules/regulations of PPAC and provide the Price Arts Foundation, Inc. with all requested information stated below as well as maintain a 2.75 GPA.

APPLICATION PROCESS, DEADLINE & ANNOUNCEMENT

All applications must be received by the Price Arts Foundation, Inc., via mail at the address listed below, no later than <u>Friday</u>, <u>June 27</u>, <u>2008</u>. Applications will be reviewed by the Scholarship Committee and each recipient will be notified by US mail, phone, and a formal announcement will be placed on the Price Arts Foundation, Inc. website <u>Friday</u>, <u>August 15</u>, <u>2008</u>. Status inquiries can be made by e-mail or US mail.

ELIGIBILITY and REQUIRED DOCUMENTS

The eligibility rules governing the competition for the Price Arts Foundation, Inc. Dream Maker Scholarships include the following:

- 1. Recipients must be between the ages of 10-18 years.
- 2. Recipients must be enrolled at PPAC, as defined by PPAC's rules and regulations, for each quarter in which they receive an award.
- 3. Recipients must be a citizen or legal Immigrant of the United States. Provide copy of birth certificate or other legal document normally accepted by US Immigration.
- 4. Annual household income must be \$35,000 or less.
- 5. Recipients must have a cumulative 2.75 Grade Point Average (GPA) for most current academic year and maintain a 2.75 GPA or higher during award quarters.
- 6. Write a personal statement (typed, not to exceed three pages) describing your academic achievements, education and career objectives, community service, personal achievements, why you should be the recipient of the scholarship, educational or economical challenges you face in your pursuit of dance training/education and any other information to be considered with respect to your scholarship application.

- 7. Attach two letters of recommendation from your dance teacher, academic teacher, or school counselor to include but not limited to: 1) how long they have known you, 2) capacity they know you, 3) educational or economical challenges you face in your pursuit of dance training/education, 4) your potential for success and any other information to be considered with your application. The letters should be submitted in a sealed envelope with the recommender's signature across the seal of the envelope.
- 8. Attach a copy of your academic transcript.
- 9. Attach a copy of monthly pay stub.
- 10. Attach a color dance picture and head shot. (Pictures will not be returned)
- 11. Submit a DVD (preferred format) or VHS of yourself dancing a classical or contemporary ballet combination and a jazz combination. Both combinations should include at a minimum 2 types of turns and 2 types of jumps. These 2 combinations are required. You may also submit an additional combination that is a style of your choice. DO NOT SUBMIT A LYRICAL COMBINATION FOR YOUR BALLET COMBINATION. The maximum length for each routine is 1 minute 30 seconds. Please state your name, age, how long you have been dancing, type of routine, and place of residence at the beginning of each routine. Please submit all routines on one DVD or VHS. Be sure to label the DVD or VHS with your name, mailing address, and contact phone number.
- 12. Applicants must meet all material submission requirements and deadlines, including the \$15 application fee. (Payments made payable to Price Arts Foundation, Inc.)
- 13. Applicants must be available for an interview if needed.

- 16. Applicants must inform the Scholarship Committee of changes of address or enrollment status. Failure to notify the Committee of any changes may affect Scholarship disbursements. Notification can be made to the address above.
- 17. The recipients agree to the use of their name, photographs, and non-specific demographic information in the news releases and promotional information about the Price Arts Foundation, Inc. scholarships.

AWARD REDEMPTION

As described above, the award is for the 2008-2009 school year and is for tuition only. Award payments are made directly to PPAC. The maximum award paid in one school-year is \$750. The award is divided into 4 quarterly payments, as defined by the school quarters for PPAC. The recipient must maintain a minimum 2.75 GPA, or their scholarship may be forfeited as determined by Price Arts Foundation, Inc. If the recipient's GPA is under 2.75, they must submit a written explanation as well as any other supportive letter(s) with the required information at each quarter. Requested information must be received as requested and approved by the Price Arts Foundation, Inc. for the award to be funded in part or in whole. Academic transcripts for the awarded school year should be submitted to the Price Arts Foundation.

FIRST PAYMENT

Once the recipient has enrolled at PPAC, they should provide the Price Arts Foundation with their curriculum of study they are enrolled in along with enrollment contact. Attendance and progress reports will be submitted to the Price Arts Foundation, Inc. in order to review for quarterly eligibility of award.

OTHER PAYMENTS

In order for the second through remaining portions of the award to be funded, the recipient must provide Price Arts Foundation, Inc. with a progress report from PPAC showing they have maintain consistent attendance and progress in their program of study at PPAC, a copy of the their current transcript reflecting a minimum GPA of 2.75; as well as their curriculum they are enrolled in for the coming quarters. Once approved by the Price Arts Foundation, the award will be funded.
